MEETING POINTS: Normally meet On Site for 9.30am start

TETANUS: Please ensure your tetanus inoculation is up to date.

Directions for the Natural England Nature Reserve, Aston Rowant

OS Map 165 – Usual meeting-point is Reserve office. We occasionally meet at two other sites, the Nature Reserve car park and Cowlease car park. Please check beforehand, if necessary.

At Nettlebed take B480 to Watlington; then take B4009 following signs for M40. Drive under Motorway (Junction 6) & take next right (A40). After ¼ mile turn right onto track (Icknield Way) signposted "Nature Reserve Office". For Nature Reserve and Cowleaze car parks continue on the road and turn right after 1 mile further on at the top of the hill. The Nature Reserve car park is on the right after ½ mile (brown sign). Cowleaze is a ½ mile further on and on the left (for Sculpture Trail) after crossing motorway.

From Christmas Common, reverse the directions.
