Directions for the Natural England Nature Reserve, Aston Rowant

Usual meeting-point is the Reserve office. We occasionally meet at three other sites, Hill Farm, the Nature Reserve car park, and Cowleaze car park. Please check the e-mail beforehand, if necessary. All four locations can be found on the map.

At Nettlebed take B481 to Watlington; then take B4009 following signs for M40.

For Hill Farm, turn right before the northbound motorway exit and continue for half a mile.


For the other 3 sites drive under Motorway (Junction 6) & take next right (A40). After 1/4 mile turn right onto track (Icknield Way) signposted "Nature Reserve Office".

For Nature Reserve and Cowleaze car parks continue on the road and turn right after 1 mile further on at the top of the hill signposted to Christmas Common. The Nature Reserve car park is on the right after ½ mile (brown sign). Cowleaze is 1 mile further on and on the left after crossing motorway.

From Christmas Common, reverse the directions.
